All proposals must be accompanied by a bid bond, bank cashier's check, bank draft, or certified check for not less than five (5) percent of the amount of the bid.

In addition, all bidders must comply with the Responsible Bidders Act of the State of Illinois. The successful bidder will be required to post performance security and to provide a Certificate of Insurance as set forth in the Invitation to Bid and the general terms and conditions. The Joliet Township Government reserves the right to reject any and all bids, part of any and all bids, or to waive technical errors or omissions in bids.

The Contract shall be subject to the provisions of the Prevailing Wage Act (80 ILCS 130/1 et seq.) to the extent required by law.

No bidder may withdraw their bid within 30 days after the actual date of the opening thereof.
