ESTABLISHMENT OF QUORUM: Supervisor Contreras begins explaining how out of the nine members, which includes the trustees who are not currently present, five members are present, which creates a quorum to proceed with the meeting.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

PURPOSE OF THE COMMITTEE: Supervisor Contreras explains how it is required to meet three times, as these meetings can occur throughout the year leading up to the report deadline, which is 18 months after the township's original committee meeting, as well as hold the meeting on the same day as a board meeting. The committee can be part of a regular township board meeting providing the list of committee members with an agenda and the majority of the committee members have to be present for quorum. On June 10th, 2022, Governor Pritzker signed to create a committee for local government as an efficiency act into law. The law now requires townships, road districts and township multi assessment districts to convene a committee to study and report on local government efficiency. This is the reason the committee was created for the Joliet township to be in compliance.

DISCUSS TIMELINE, ASSIGNMENTS & REPORTS: Supervisor Contreras informs the members how the committee meetings will be jointly or back-to-back with the Road District's own decennial committee meetings.

Supervisor Contreras inquires if all members agree to have the decennial committee meetings month to month by the next board meeting to fulfill the three-time requirement as all the members agree with that arrangement. The next upcoming meeting in January will have reports on what the township has been working on for the last couple of years. Supervisor Contreras will update the members on the materials that way reports can be made, and discussions can be had. The Road District will be providing their report, although it will be Road District's first meeting for the next scheduled committee meeting. Sufficient time was given out via the newspaper informing the public to participate.

ANNOUNCE SCHEDULE REQUIREMENTS & SET UP NEXT MEETING DATE: The next scheduled meetings will be held January 9th, February 13th and March 12th of 2024 at 4:30 PM.
