**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Angel Contreras introduced the Municipal Vehicle Program, which allows agencies working with Joliet Township Government to obtain their own vehicles at a discounted rate through a third-party agreement with PACE. Each agency would be responsible for their own vehicles, drivers, gas, and maintenance, and would need to go through PACE training to participate. The timeline for implementation will vary for each organization and could take several months based on their experience.

The conversation also touched on the specific requirements for drivers and the flexibility of the program. Angel Contreras stressed the importance of individual meetings to address the specific contract needs of each organization, rather than contacting the PACE representative directly.

LeShae Hudson inquired about the possibility of existing staff taking training to become drivers, to which Angel Contreras confirmed that it is possible. The conversation also touched on the specific requirements for drivers and the flexibility of the program.

Kevin Nolen expressed interest in the MOU and Angel provided detailed information about the process, pricing, and flexibility of the service, assuring Kevin that there are no timing restrictions. They agreed to continue the discussion, and Angel offered to send over the necessary information. There were members of the Reimagine Village as well as partner municipalities present such as the Kane County Sheriff's Office and the Lake County State's Attorney's Office. The representatives were also interested in joining an intergovernmental agreement with the Joliet Township Government Transportation Department.
