


JOLIET TOWNSHIP ORGANIZATIONAL CHART

ABOUT THE ROAD DISTRICT

The Road District is responsible for maintaining over 60 miles of roadways and six bridges within the Joliet Township's jurisdiction.

The Road District is under the leadership of the Highway Commissioner. The Highway Commissioner oversees the construction, maintenance, and repair of roads and bridges within the township. Their primary duties include awarding contracts, hiring workers, and purchasing materials for road projects. They are also required to submit a monthly report to the Will County Highway Commissioner.


RESPONSIBILITIES

The Road District offers various services, such as parkway tree maintenance, street sign requests, graffiti removal, dumping/animal street cleanup, culvert/drainage maintenance, street maintenance/potholes, streetlight outage, tall grass/weeds and more. Township residents can also submit oversize/overweight vehicle permits and special event street closure permits through the Road District.
