**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN
SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO JOLIET TOWNSHIP, WILL
COUNTY, ILLINOIS FROM THE CVI BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROGRAM**

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WHEREAS, Joliet Township, Will County, State of Illinois (the “Township”) is a duly organized and existing township and a unit of local government organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, *et. seq.*, and all laws amendatory thereto; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 30-50 of the Illinois Township Code, the township board may vote to sell or otherwise dispose of personal property and may declare property surplus or otherwise no longer necessary or useful to the Township, *see* 60 ILCS 1/30-50; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and Township Board of Trustees for Joliet Township (the “Township Board”) have identified certain items of Personal Property owned by the Township that are no longer useful, required, or desirous to be retained and maintained by the Township, said property being identified and described in “**Exhibit A**” (the “Property”); and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has determined that the Property is no longer necessary or useful to the Township, that it is no longer in the best interests of the Township to retain said Property, and it is in the best interests of the Township to dispose of same; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has further determined that the Property is obsolete, unusable, surplus without any significant monetary value.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of Joliet Township, Will County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That all of the recitals and legislative findings contained in the preambles to this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2: The Township Board hereby finds and declares that the Property listed and

identified on **Exhibit A**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, is surplus property without any material monetary value and is no longer of any use to Joliet Township. The Township Board finds that it is in the best interests of the Township to donate, dispose, and/or recycle said Property.

SECTION 3: The Township Board hereby finds that the Property listed on **Exhibit A** shall be sold or otherwise disposed of by the Township. Specifically, the Township Supervisor is hereby authorized to determine the manner of sale or disposal that the Township Supervisor determines to be in the best interests of the Township.

SECTION 4: The Township Supervisor is hereby authorized to arrange for and effectuate the sale or other disposition of the Property listed on **Exhibit A**. The Township Supervisor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver any and all documents necessary to implement the provisions of this Resolution and the conveyance and/or transfer of the Property. The Township Board explicitly authorizes the Supervisor to effectuate the sale or donation of the Property to another governmental body without competitive bidding pursuant to Section 30-50 of the Illinois Township Code or, if unable to find a recipient, the Supervisor is authorized to dispose of the Property as recycling or waste.

SECTION 5. If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

SECTION 6: All resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 7: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

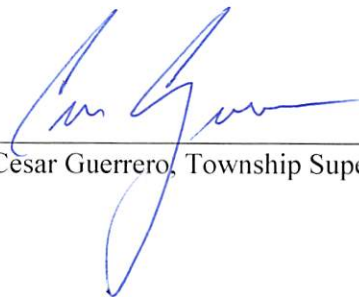
