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WHEREAS, Joliet Township, County of Will, State of Illinois (the "Township") is a duly organized and existing township and a unit of a local government organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Township, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, *et seq.*, and all laws amendatory thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Township has met from time to time in closed session for purposes authorized by the Illinois Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/1, *et seq.*, (the "OMA"); and

WHEREAS, the Township has kept written minutes of all such meetings held in closed session, as required by the OMA; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.06 of the OMA requires public bodies to periodically, but no less than semi-annually, meet to review the minutes of closed sessions; and

WHEREAS, the Supervisor and the Board of Trustees (the "Board") has further determined that the minutes listed in Schedule A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, shall be and are hereby retained as confidential, pending further review in the future to determine their eligibility for release.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of Joliet Township, Will County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution by reference.

SECTION 2: The Township Board has determined that the closed session minutes from those meetings set forth in **Schedule A** shall be and hereby are retained as confidential, pending further review in the future to determine their eligibility for release.

SECTION 3: The provisions of this Resolution are hereby declared to be severable, and should any provision of this Resolution be determined to be in conflict with any law, statute, or regulation by a court of competent jurisdiction, said provision shall be excluded and deemed inoperative, unenforceable, and as though not provided for herein, but such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid

application or provision, and all other provisions shall remain unaffected, unimpaired, valid, and in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: All resolutions, rules, and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby superseded and repealed.

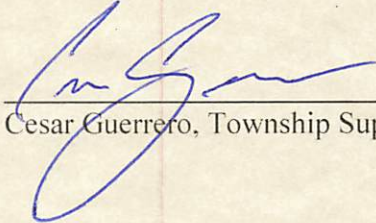
SECTION 5: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval according to law.

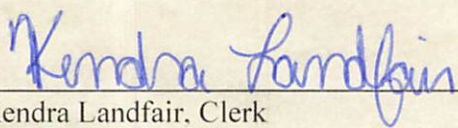

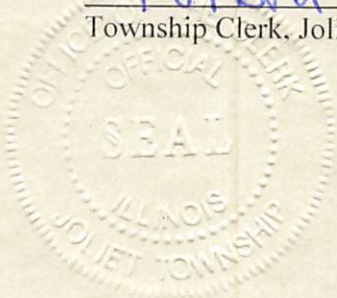
