**AN ORDINANCE RATIFYING AMENDMENTS TO AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN
JOLIET TOWNSHIP AND PACE FOR PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SERVICES**

WHEREAS, Joliet Township, Will County, State of Illinois (the “Township”) is a duly organized and existing township and a unit of local government organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and is operating under the provisions of the Illinois Township Code, 60 ILCS 1/1-1, *et. seq.*, and all laws amendatory thereto; and

WHEREAS, Joliet Township (the “Township”) has previously approved and entered into an agreement with PACE for public transportation services as part of the PACE Municipal Vehicle Program (the “Agreement”); and

WHEREAS, a few amendments to the Agreement have been made and presented to the Township for consideration, and such amendments have been attached as **Exhibit A**; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board finds it in the best interest of the Township to ratify and confirm the Amendments to the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Supervisor and the Board of Trustees of Joliet Township, Will County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That all of the recitals and legislative findings contained in the preambles to this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this Ordinance as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: That the Board hereby finds and declares that the amendments identified in **Exhibit A**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, are hereby acceptable and approved.

Section 3: If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4: All ordinances, resolutions, motions and/or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

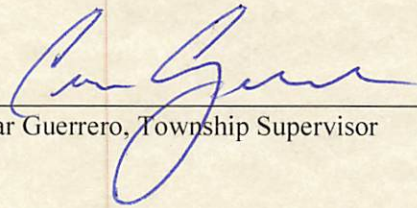
Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.

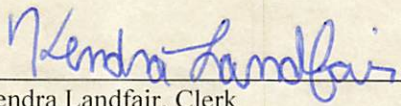
